What to Include:

- Couple's names
- Wedding date
- Location (city + state is helpful, even if venue isn't booked yet)
- Notice for a formal invitation to follow
- Wedding website is great, although not necessary

Etiquette:

- When to send them out:

8-12 months for destination wedding
6-8 months for local



- How to address envelopes:

Use professional titles or "Mr.," "Mrs.," or "Ms."

No nicknames or abbreviations


Spell out the street address completely

Provide return address in upper left-hand corner or back flap

Samples:

To a married couple

Mr. and Mrs. Matthew Bennett



To families with children under the age of 18

**Mr. and Mrs. Anton Ricci
Benson, Violet, and Bella**

To an unmarried couple (list the person you're closest to first)

Ms. Claudia Butler and Mr. Jason Jenkins

To a single man or woman with a guest

Ms. Genevieve Jones and Guest
